### *Agricola*

1600s-present (Online via Griffin)

This index covers all types of publications on every major agricultural subject.

### *Biological Abstracts*

1992-present available through *Griffin* online catalog terminals, select Articles Indexes Full-Text and More, go to

Alphabetical Listing and scroll down to *Biological Abstracts*

1926-1995 available in print at Owen A&I

Biological Abstracts is the major index for references and abstracts to journal articles in the biological sciences.

### *Entomology Abstracts*

1969-1994 available in print at Owen A&I QL461 .E9853

This index includes citations and abstracts for all topics with direct relevance to entomology.

### *Article1st*

1990-present available through *Griffin* online catalog terminals, select Articles Indexes Full-Text and More, go to

Alphabetical Listing and scroll down to *Article1st*

This database indexes over 12,500 journals in science, technology, medicine, social science, business, the humanities, and popular culture.

### *Science Citation Index*

1990-present available through *Griffin* online catalog terminals, select Articles Indexes Full-Text and More, go to

Alphabetical Listing and scroll down to *Web of Science*

1955-1991 available in print at Owen A&I East Alcove

This is a multidisciplinary index to articles in over 6,000 science journals. A unique feature allows a "citation" search to find who referenced a particular article.

### *VET – Veterinary Science and Animal Health*

1973-present available through *Griffin* online catalog terminals, select Articles Indexes Full-Text and More, go to

Alphabetical Listing and scroll down to *VET – Veterinary Sci & Animal Health*

Lists references to publications covering all aspects of veterinary medicine including animal diseases; physiology and biotechnology of domestic animals; meat inspection and animal husbandry; fungal, arthropod, helminth and protozoal infestations of wild and domestic animals.

### *Zoological Record*

1926-1994 (print Owen A&I Z7991.Z87)

1864-1925 (print Owen stacks Z7991.Z87)

This is the granddaddy of all zoology indexes published since 1864. Sections 13A-13F on insects include:

General Insecta & Smaller Orders, Coleoptera, Diptera, Lepidoptera, Hymenoptera and Hemiptera.
