## **Griffin/Summit**      <<http://griffin.wsu.edu/search~>>

Use Griffin, our online catalog, to search for philosophical works, philosophical criticism and historical works on philosophy. You can search by the author's name, title, or keyword. If you are looking for books *about* a given author, try a keyword search of his or her name. Keyword searches may be used to examine library bibliographic records to determine more precise library catalog subject headings. In Griffin, these headings may be clicked to access library resources with a given subject heading.

You can also search Summit, a catalog of materials from colleges and universities in Washington and Oregon by pressing the "Search Summit" button that appears in a bibliographic record. You can request books that you find in other libraries through Summit to be sent to our campus for you to pick up. Please note that only items which are lost, checked out, missing, or otherwise unavailable through the WSU Libraries are available to check out through Summit. Access to your library record, ordering books through *Summit* <<http://summit.orbiscascade.org/>> or utilizing some of the resources in *Griffin* will require a WSU Campus Network ID and Password.

## **Guides and Encyclopedias**

There are numerous guides and encyclopedias of philosophy in the Holland Reference collection. Try browsing the shelves near by a given resource to find more. You can also do keyword searches that are limited to the location "WSU Holland Reference."

### **Databases and Indexes**

Use these databases to locate citations for journal articles, then use Griffin to locate the journals. Online databases are available online via the WSU Libraries "Article Indexes/E-journals" web page at <http://www.systems.wsu.edu/griffin/INDEXES.htm>.

*The Philosopher's Index*  
Holland Reference B1 .P4 1967/68 – 2008  
Indexes philosophy books and articles in English, French, German, and Italian by author and subject.

*Arts and Humanities Search*  
Indexes humanities and arts journals and resources. Especially useful for interdisciplinary topics.

*Iter (Medieval and Renaissance)*  
Indexes Medieval and Renaissance scholarship in cultural studies and history.

## **Electronic Journal Collections**

### *Project Muse*

Includes searchable full text articles for over 90 humanities and cultural studies journals.

### *Electronic Collections Online (ECO)*

Includes searchable full text articles for journals in a variety of academic disciplines, including philosophy.

### *JSTOR*

Provides searchable full text archives for journal issues older than 5 years in a variety of academic disciplines.

### *MLA*

Contains articles on philosophers and philosophical topics. The online version has coverage from 1926 to the present and includes some full-text article.

### *Academic Search Complete*

Includes searchable full text articles for newspapers, magazines, and some academic journals.

## **Bibliographies**

Bibliographies are annotated lists of reviews and articles written about a given author or topic. They can be especially useful for locating historical and interpretative material. You can use Griffin keyword searches to locate bibliographies (i.e., "Plato bibliography").
